6 thru 10 yearly	WELL EXAM	Immunizations as needed additional testing and screening as needed
11 or 12 year	WELL EXAM	Tdap, MCV4*, HPV9****
12 to 15 – Yearly Teen Exam	Catch up Imms as needed	Teen Screen Questionnaire Counseling**
16 year	WELL EXAM	MCV4*, MenB**** Teen Screen Questionnaire Counseling**
17 to 18 year – WELL EXAM	Catch up Imms as needed	Teen Screen Questionnaire Counseling**
*****All children 6 months and over should get Influenza vaccine according to the current year’s recommendations*****		
*****All children 6 months and over should get COVID19 vaccine according to the current recommendations*****		
* Some vaccines are required for kindergarten and may be postponed until the 5-year exam if it is before the child starts kindergarten.		
** This is done at our office. There is an additional charge for this service, which may not be covered by your insurance.		
**** HPV9 and MenB are a 2 or 3-dose series depending on age, requiring additional visits.		
KEY: HepB = Hepatitis B, PENTA = Diphtheria+Tetanus+Acellular Pertussis+HiB+IPV, VAXELIS = Diphtheria+Tetanus+Acellular Pertussis+HiB+HepB+IPV, PCV20 = Pneumococcal 20-valent Conjugate, ROTA = Rotavirus, QUADRA = Diphtheria+Tetanus+Acellular Pertussis+IPV, MMRV = Measles+Mumps+Rubella+Varicella (Chickenpox), HepA = Hepatitis A, Tdap = Tetanus+Diphtheria + Acellular Pertussis, MCV4 = Meningococcal serogroup A,C,W,Y, HPV9 = Human Papillomavirus, MenB = Meningococcal serogroup B
